## Background

Torpoint was asked to construct a new Two Storey brick & trespa clad Extension for Feversham Girls College, along with extensive external works, car parking and drainage.

As the school was a Muslim girls school, we had to ensure that all workmen were not visible to the pupils of the school, this was achieved by infilling with obscure materials to all windows overlooking then new extension and a full/solid 2.4m timber hoarding surrounding the perimeter of the works



## Description of Works:

The project involved the following:-

- New 2 storey steel framed extension constructed of block and facing, with a Trespa clad and also a rendered staircase area.
- The Extension was constructed to provide the school with 7 new class rooms, a media centre, new toilets and reception area.
